


**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) BETWEEN  
OSNABRÜCK UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES, GERMANY,  
Faculty of Business Management and Social Sciences**

**And**

**NIZHYN MYKOLA GOGOL STATE UNIVERSITY, UKRAINE**

1. The Faculty of Business Management and Social Sciences of Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences and the Nizhyn Mykola Gogol State University hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in furtherance of the internationalization of higher education. Both parties express their interest in:
  - a. encouraging visits by faculty members from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research, teaching or other educational activities;
  - b. supporting the exchange of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students for study and research;
  - c. facilitating the exchange of non-academic staff for exchange of experiences;
  - d. fostering the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and
  - e. promoting joint research activities and other academic activities that are of mutual interest and that enhance the above-mentioned goals.
2. Both parties recognize that this Memorandum of Understanding establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest and does not in itself impose any obligations on either university. Both institutions concur that all financial arrangements necessary to implement this Memorandum of Understanding or any subsequent activity or agreement must be negotiated according to the regulations of each university and depend upon the availability of funds.
3. All activities shall be in accordance with the regulations and policies of Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences and Nizhyn Mykola Gogol State University.
4. The terms of cooperation for each activity implemented under this Memorandum shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by the parties involved prior to the initiation of that activity. The same applies if activities shall be implemented that involve other than the above mentioned Faculty.
5. The MoU is valid for five years following the date of signing. Both universities agree to review this MoU then and enter into negotiations pertaining to the renewal or revision of the agreement. If one party wishes to terminate or revise this MoU before the expiration date it has to give the other party a written notice at least 6 months in advance
